

- 2. Please ensure you complete all four parts of this form.
- 3. Complete part 3 by ticking the appropriate boxes and following the directions given.
- 4. After completion, please send the form together with the other documents specified, to the Registrar of British Ships, Guernsey.
- 5. A ship is entitled to be registered if 33 of the 64 shares are legally and beneficially owned by qualified persons (as defined in part 3). Joint owners of a share must all be qualified persons for that share to count towards the 33 shares required.

A **qualified person** is a citizen/subject/body corporate as defined in the **categories** below:

- (a) a British citizen;
- (b) a British Dependent Territories citizen;
- (c) a British Overseas citizen
- (d) a British Subject under the 1981 Act;
- (e) persons who under the Hong Kong (British Nationality) Order 1986 are British Nationals (Overseas).
- (f) bodies corporate incorporated in the Bailiwick of Guernsey or in any relevant overseas territory and having their principal place of business in the Bailiwick of Guernsey or in any such territory; and

The relevant overseas territories are:

the United Kingdom the Isle of Man the Bailiwick of Jersey or any colony (e.g. Anguilla, Bermuda, Cayman Islands, Falkland Islands, Gibraltar, Montserrat, St Helena, Turks & Caicos Islands).

A REPRESENTATIVE PERSON IS EITHER:-

- (i) an individual resident of the Bailiwick of Guernsey, or
- (ii) a body corporate incorporated in the Bailiwick of Guernsey and having its principal place of business there.

You must appoint a **Bailiwick of Guernsey Resident** as a Representative Person and either an owner, the representative person, or some other individual or Body Corporate as Manager. All joint owners must appoint the same Representative Person and Manager.
