Subject	East Guernsey – Cable Reburial

The vessel CS RECORDER will be undertaking sea bed works in the Havelet Bay area and in an area 3.5 miles south of Lower Heads to bury existing undersea cable commencing Monday 15th May 2017 for approximately seven days.

Mariners are requested to give CS RECORDER a wide berth.

Re-Burial of Cable Section - CIEG Guernsey - Jersey 90kv Subsea Power

Please be advised that CIEG are planning to re-bury 2 sections of cable and the associated joints between the $\underline{15^{\text{th}} \text{ May } 2017}$ and the $\underline{22^{\text{nd}} \text{ May } 2017}$

It is imperative that Mariners <u>keep a minimum distance of 500 meters between themselves and the ship</u> to allow for underwater operations.

Fishermen are asked to remove any fishing gear in the vicinity on or near the areas shown below prior to the ships arrival.



Cable Repair 1 - Jersey to Guernsey (2012)

Please note: The repaired sections lay between 49°22.736'N 002°29.220'W and 49°22.360'N 002°28.494'W and has a hairpin bight facing west south west extending for 370 meters to 49°22.610'N 002°29.412'W as shown in the image below.



Cable Repair 2 – Jersey to Guernsey (2015)

Please note: The repaired sections lay between N49 26.9649 W002 31.4225 to N49 26.8732 W002 31.1251 where it then heads south to N49 26.5835 W002 31.1909. The hairpin bight facing west south west extending for 70 meters to N49 26.8873 W002 31.3212 as shown in the image below.
