Subject	COVID – 19 Pleasure Vessels Not Registered
	In The Bailiwick of Guernsey

Due to the ongoing **COVID-19** situation in mainland Europe and the UK the Visitor's Moorings in Guernsey, Alderney, Sark and Herm are closed to all vessels from outside of the Bailiwick of Guernsey.

St Peter Port will only accept visiting vessels from outside of the Bailiwick if there is an urgent requirement to do so.

<u>Any</u> vessel visiting the Bailiwick of Guernsey must first contact **Guernsey VTS on VHF #12** or **Alderney Port Control on VHF #74** declaring which country they have come from, if there is any sickness on board and the <u>urgent</u> nature of their visit.

All visiting vessels will be moored in isolation and no crews are to proceed ashore for at least <u>14 days</u> and then, only on authorisation from the Director of Public Health.

Any vessels needing to urgently take fuel will be able to do so, however there is to be no physical interaction between the fuel supplier and the crew of the vessel. All payments for services must be made remotely.

Whilst vessels/crews are in isolation communication to shore can be made by contacting Victoria Marina Office on VHF#80 (from 06:00 to 22:00), Alderney Port Control on VHF #74 (during the working day) or Guernsey VTS on #12 at all other times.
