

Local Notices to Mariners

l – Guernsey Yacht Club – Parade urday 1 st August 2020

Vessels will be taking part in The Guernsey Yacht Club's 130th Anniversary Sail Past on **Saturday 1**st **August at approximately 16:30.**

A safety briefing will take place at the Club on Saturday morning at 11:00.

It is anticipated that boats will congregate in Belle Greve Bay and The Little Russell North of Reffee before forming a line and motoring in an orderly procession past the Castle Breakwater within Race Mark D (Distance), this is the most northerly of two yellow buoys East of the Castle with an "X" topmark, and then proceed South around Gabrielle buoy (K) and returning North before dispersing.

Smaller dinghies and rowing boats will exit St Peter Port harbour, around the breakwater, through the Distance mark and around Terres buoy (T) before returning.

A starting cannon will be fired from the race hut in the Castle for the first boat and last boat in the parade.

Announcements will be made on the day on Ch77 and boat owners are also advised that a rowing race will also be taking place with announcements also on Ch77.

It is anticipated that the Sail Past will finish by 17:30.


Vessels not taking part in the Sail Past are requested to keep their distance and be aware of any wash with smaller boats and dinghies.
