

## **Local Notices to Mariners**

LNTM No.	003/2022
Subject	COVID 19 – 19 January 2022 - Locally Registered and Visiting Leisure Vessels Re-Entering/Entering the Bailiwick of Guernsey

- All travellers are advised to test before a journey into the Bailiwick of Guernsey.
- All arrivals into the Bailiwick must be registered on the Travel Tracker within 8
  days prior to their arrival into the Bailiwick. Welcome to the Travel Tracker |

- On arrival into the Bailiwick proceed to St Peter Port (Guernsey) or Braye Harbour (Alderney). On arrival into St Peter Port contact Victoria Marina on VHF Ch.80 for further instructions and to confirm your Travel Tracker status. On arrival into Braye Harbour contact the Alderney Harbour Authority on VHF Ch.74.

## From 00.01 Wednesday 19 January 2022,

- Travel from within the Common Travel Area (CTA)
  - 1. There will be no testing or isolation requirements for travellers from within the CTA regardless of vaccination status ("Blue Channel" status).
- Travel from outside of the Common Travel Area (CTA)

Any travellers arriving from outside of the CTA within the last 10 days will be required to:

- For vaccinated travellers from rest of the world (excluding UK red list)
  - 1. Purchase pack of 5 Lateral flow tests (LFTs) for travellers aged 12 and over.
  - 2. Mandatory day of arrival LFT test. (you must use the remaining tests on days 3, 5, 7 and 9 after your arrival).
  - 3. Children aged 5 11 years will be provided with 5 LFTs free of charge. Children under the age of 11 must be registered on the Travel Tracker

- account of one travelling adult only. It is a legal requirement\* to undertake an LFT on the day of your arrival.
- 4. For unvaccinated children aged 12-17, the parent's vaccine information can be added to the child's travel tracker account so they can benefit from this vaccinated status.
- 5. 12 17 year olds with one dose of vaccine plus 14 days since dose, are considered to be fully vaccinated.

## For unvaccinated travellers - from rest of the world (excluding UK red list)

- 1. Day 1 PCR and Day 8 PCR tests for travellers aged 12 and over and isolate until Day 8 negative result.
- 2. Children aged 5-11 will not be PCR tested, instead they will be provided with 5 LFTs free of charge. They follow the same self-isolation requirements as accompanying parents/guardians. Children under the age of 11 must be registered on the Travel Tracker account of one travelling adult only. It is a legal requirement\* to undertake an LFT on the day of your arrival and then an LFT on days 3, 5, 7 and 9 after your arrival.
- 3. Unvaccinated children aged 12-17 will be tested and follow the same self-isolation requirements as accompanying parents/guardians. If the parents are vaccinated the parent's vaccine details can be added to the child's travel tracker account so the child can benefit from this vaccinated status. (See vaccinated travellers above)
- 4. 12 17 year olds with one dose of vaccine plus 14 days since dose are considered fully vaccinated.

## For all travellers, vaccinated and unvaccinated, travelling directly into the Bailiwick from a region on the UK's red list

- 1. Day 1 PCR and Day 9 PCR tests for travellers aged 12 and over.
- 2. Isolate until Day 9 negative result.
- 3. Children aged 5-11 will not be PCR tested, instead will be provided with 5 LFTs free of charge. They follow the same self-isolation requirements as accompanying parents/guardians. Children under the age of 11 must be registered on the Travel Tracker account of one travelling adult only.
- 4. If a test is declined then the traveller must self-isolate for 10 days.
- For all travellers, vaccinated and unvaccinated, travelling from a region on the UK's red list via the UK into the Bailiwick
  - 1. You cannot transit through the UK. You must complete self-isolation requirements in the UK.



Captain David Barker Harbour Master 2. Once completed, you can travel as a Blue Channel traveller. (See Blue Channel above).

CTA - Common Travel Area: United Kingdom, the Bailiwick of Guernsey, the Bailiwick of Jersey, the Isle of Man and the Republic of Ireland.

**Fully vaccinated** = The traveller can provide the necessary proof they have received a full course of an approved vaccine (AstraZeneca, Pfizer, Moderna and Jannsen) and 14 days have passed since their last dose.

\*It is a criminal offence to fail to follow all of the testing, self-isolation or other requirements imposed on you linked to your travel history. You may be prosecuted, and if convicted, could be sentenced to a fine of up to £10,000, 3 months' imprisonment, or both.
